#### 1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of Sunshine Coast Hospice Society as at March 31, 2023, and the statements of changes in net assets and revenues and expenditures for the year then ended is on the historical cost and cash basis of accounting except for the following:

- · Accounts receivable
- · Investments recorded at the adjusted cost base
- · Accounts payable and accrued liabilities
- Contributions are recognized upon receipt unless the contribution is received in the current year and is to be applied to future programs and operating expenses.

#### 2. NATURE OF SOCIETY

The Sunshine Coast Hospice Society (the "Society") is incorporated under the Societies Act of British Columbia. The Society provides compassionate, respectful, end-of-life and bereavement support for residents of the Sunshine Coast.

The Society is a registered charity within the definition of the Income Tax Act, and therefore, as long as it complies with the rules and regulations of the Income Tax Act, it is exempt from income taxes and may issue receipts to donors.

### 3. RESTRICTED CASH

The current year restricted cash balance consists of the Province of BC Gaming Grant funds. The externally restricted funds held for investment included in the prior year restricted cash balance were transferred and are now held in an investment account with PH&N Investment Services.

#### 7. RESTRICTED NET ASSETS

At the end of the current year the Society held \$335,843 (2022 \$423,039) of internally restricted funds for a prospective capital project to create a new expanded hospice facility. The initial term deposits were approved at board meetings held during the year in which the term deposits were made. The interest earned on the term deposits was restricted by the board on April 25, 2019. The dates of board approval and the term deposit balances at March 31, 2023 are summarized below.
